

INSURANCE REFERRAL POLICY

It is the patient's responsibility to obtain a referral. If your insurance plan requires a referral, we must have it at the time of your visit. Otherwise, we will have to reschedule your appointment. As a courtesy, our office sends reminder calls with this information as well as faxing a request to your Primary Care Physician (PCP) prior to your appointment. Most health insurance plans will not pay for referred doctor visits that have not been approved by your PCP in advance. If you are unsure if you need a referral to see a specialist, check with your insurance company or your PCP. Please contact your PCP office at least 5 business days prior to your appointment to allow sufficient time for processing. Thank you for your cooperation.
